RULES



- 1. Entries accepted only from paid-up members of Speech and Drama Teachers of Ireland on official entry form. Only entries correctly listed as per the programme will be accepted.
- 2. Time limits will be strictly enforced. If competitors exceed the time limit, as a result, they will not be able to be considered for a prize. A full adjudication sheet will be provided but a mark will not be allocated.
- 3. Only online entries accepted. Entries to be submitted from 14th January to 11th February 2020. Absolutely no late entries will be accepted.
- 4. Fees must accompany all entries.
- 5. The minimum entry requirement for any competition to proceed is 5 in the case of solo events and 3 in group events. ___
- 6. Once set, competition time and date cannot be changed.
- 7. Competitors must be within the stated age range on the 1st January 2020. It is the responsibility of the teacher to ensure that their pupils are correctly entered.
- 8. All competitors must perform as per their entry number i.e. in sequence.
- 9. Competitors must not repeat selections performed by them in any of our previous festivals.
- 10. Competitors must supply a clean copy of their chosen piece to the adjudicator on the day of the festival. THIS WILL NOT BE RETURNED.
- 11. Competitors are requested not to wear their school uniform.
- 12. Competitors must set their own stage and are responsible for playing/switching on their sound effects in the relevant competition. Teachers or parents will not be allowed to assist in any way.
- 13. The Board reserves the right to split competitions on the basis of entry numbers received.
- 14. The decision of the Adjudicator is final. No one may approach the Adjudicator.
- 15. The Board reserves the right to refuse entries.
- 16. Holders of Teaching Diplomas are not eligible to compete.
- 17. No teachers are allowed to enter students on the day of festival.
